

### **General Information**

NOITS 2006 will be held at the University of Iceland, Economic Faculty May 12.-13. Presentations both days will take place in a department building called ODDI, which is straight across the street from Radison SAS Saga Hotel. The street in between is called Sudurgata. There is a 5 minutes walk from the hotel to the conference room at the University. The conference room in ODDI is number 101. And we will meet in front of room 101 for coffee before the workshop starts.

### **Accommodation**

We have made reservations for the group referred to NOITS, so when you arrive and when you pay you need to refer to that, since the University has discount prices at Radison SAS Saga Hotel. You pay yourself for the hotel and then we pay you back afterwards.
